Frequently Asked Questions and Helpful Information:

- All prices listed have sales tax already in-cluded
- Cash or Check Only
- Please make checks payable to Cline's Landscapes
- One loader bucket is 3/4 yds, approxi-mately 20.25 cubic feet of organic material and 6/10 yds, approxi-mately 16.2 cubic feet of other materials.
- Large frame 1/2 ton truck with a long bed can hold 4-5 buckets of mulch and 1 bucket of heavy material.
- Large frame 1/2 ton truck with a short bed can hold 3 buckets of mulch and 1 bucket of heavy material.
- Small frame truck with a long bed can hold 3 buckets of mulch and 1 bucket of heavy material.
- Small frame truck with a short bed can hold 2 buckets of mulch and 1 bucket of heavy material.
- How much mulch do you need? Measure the size of the area you are going to cover and then contact us and we can compute the amount you need. (Length x width x depth)
- New mulch beds need a depth of 3-4 inches of organic material. Non-organic mulch beds needs a depth of 2 inches
- Termites do not feed on bark mulch accord-ing to the information from the Extension
- Forest Resources & NC State University. They require solid wood as a food source, such as buried pieces of lumber.
- We can haul a maximum of 21 loader buckets of organic material or 9 loader buckets of heavy material such as stone and dirt.
- Deliveries are made inside curb lines on lots at the cus-tomers risk only.
- Spreading gravel with a dump truck is not a service you are charged for.
